Luxury home furnishings offered by an artists' cooperative. 29 plates in superb contemporary color.
  4. **Parentalia Mariae Clementinae.** [Rome 1736]. Folio. \$1600  
2 folding plates. Obsequies for Maria Clementina Sobieski, the wife of James Stuart prince of Wales.

For the devout traveler. Preserved in two blind-decorated black morocco pull-off boxes. *Not* a first ed.

A miniature picture Bible as emblem book. 222 engravings after Merian. Contemporary vellum.

Latin paraphrases of the Gradual, Penitential & Matins Psalms. Contemporary vellum.

The most original picture Bible of the late Renaissance. 172 woodcuts in ornamental frames.

Contemporary vellum mourning binding. The last days of Louis XIII, recounted by his almoner.

The dedication copy. Contemporary red morocco. A history of the Poor Hermits of St. Jerome.
17. **Combault.** *Blanche Infante de Castille.* Paris 1644. 4to. \$1350  
Feminist life of the virago Queen Blanche of Castile (1188-1252). Etched frontispiece.
18. **Roca.** *Epitome de la Vida...del Invicto...Carlos V.* Madrid 1622. 4to. \$4800  
Mirror of a Prince — the great-grandfather of the 15-year-old heir to the throne. Etched plate.

The first biography of a founder of the Humanist school of law. No other copy outside Italy.

The dedication copy, printed on light blue paper. Contemporary gilt armorial tan calf with inlays.

*Editiones principes.* Presentation copy. Edited from a ms. in Pithou's library. Contemporary vellum.
22. **Leoncillus.** *Paupertatis Opes.* Ferrara 1649. Folio. \$7500  
Another dedication copy. The first extensive treatment of poor laws. Contemporary red morocco.
23. **Lucidoro.** *De Illegitimis Clericorum.* Perugia 1648. 4to. \$3650  
Another dedication copy. The first substantial work devoted to the bastards of Catholic clergy.
24. **Rouquette.** *L'Arithmétique Choisie.* Bordeaux 1751. 8vo. \$2400  
Gilt-lettered red morocco presentation binding. Text signed twice by the author to prevent piracy.
25. **Sweerts.** *XII Caesarum Romanorum Imagines [& 1 other].* Antwerp 1603. 4to. \$4800  
Author's presentation copy. 12 fine etchings of coins in his collection. 19th-century red morocco.

The first published treatise on vegetarianism. Contemporary vellum.

One of three books from the author's private press. Contemporary blind-tooled pigskin.

One of the first books by Zwolle's prototypographer. Rubricated.

Medieval Humanist encyclopedia. Rubricated & prepared for study. Contemporary manuscript index.

On conduct, reading & education. Rubricated. Another early book from Zwolle's first press.

A fight over Biblical translation by a contributor to the Complutensian Bible.

On the types & property of clergy. Printed by the woodcutter Lucantonio degli Uberti.

On the Holy Cross of St. Martinskerck. Etched frontispiece.
